Hospice play boost

A south Norfolk children's hospice has received a financial boost, thanks to a donation from a Norfolk businessman.

The East Anglia's Children's Hospices (EACH) centre at Quidenham received £500, which will go to the refurbishment of its playroom, which last received a make-over 10 years ago.

The hospice was one of 18 East Anglian charities and community causes to have benefited from £10,000 of cash awards given away by Norwich-based Almary Green Investments.

The fund was set aside by Carl Lamb, managing director of Almary Green, to mark his firm's 10th anniversary.

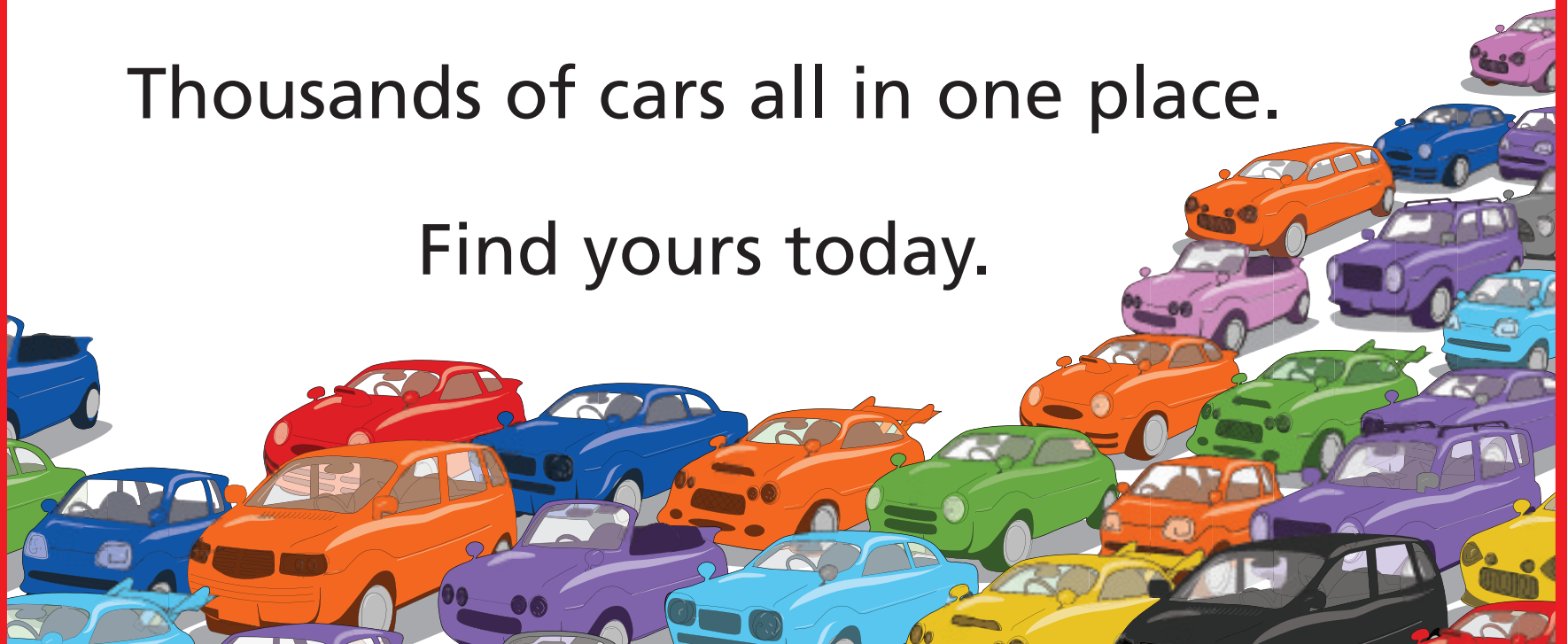
